Criteria for \$1000 Scholarship

To qualify applicant must be a female college bound high school senior in Ulster County that demonstrates a strong commitment to volunteering and plans to further her education. The recipient must show contributions to her community through volunteer service. A special committee appointed by the Junior League of Kingston, NY, Inc. will select the recipient.

Application Requirements

1. A completed application and supporting documentation to be received no later than March 28, 2017.
2. Documentation of community service.
3. Three letters of recommendation, one from **each** of the following categories. Name, address and contact number of author are required:
 - Community Service Reference
 - Personal Reference
 - Advisor/Teacher Reference
4. Prepare a one page essay describing their volunteer experiences and how these activities benefited them and their community.
5. The Committee reserves the option to request an interview.
