CRITERIA FOR \$1000 SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will be awarded to a female living in Ulster County or Junior League of Kingston's surrounding service area, returning to or beginning college as a full time "nontraditional" student. This woman is enrolled in an Associates or Bachelor degree program and demonstrates plans and a strong commitment to further her education and develop her potential. A special committee appointed by the Junior League of Kingston, NY, Inc. will select the recipient.

Application Requirements

1. A completed application to be received no later than April 14, 2018.
2. Documentation of current enrollment (acceptance) or most recent transcripts in an accredited Associates or Bachelor degree program.
3. Non-traditional student status: age 25 or more.
4. A personal letter of recommendation is suggested from an individual having association with you either through education or volunteer aspects of life (please have them include their name, address and contact number)
5. Developing the potential of women is part of the Junior League of Kingston's mission statement in an attached essay please elaborate:
"This scholarship will assist in providing me the opportunity to reach my personal potential and goal to....."
